The University of North Carolina, the North Carolina Independent Colleges and Universities, the North Carolina Community College System, and the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction are joining together with many non-profit and community partners to bring a unified focus to extending and improving entrepreneurship education for people of all ages in our state. Other initiating partners include NC REAL Enterprises, NC 4-H Youth Development, and the North Carolina Rural Economic Development Center.

These partners believe that entrepreneurship education is important both for people who want to become entrepreneurs and for people who want to work for entrepreneurs, all are engines of our economy.

At the Consortium's Kick-off event on September 28th at Elon University, leaders met to form work groups and discuss strategies. February 25th will be the 2nd statewide event, held in tandem with the 2008 NC Entrepreneurship Summit during National Entrepreneurship Week.
